1) A cupcake stall is one of the easiest ways to start fundraising. If you already know how to make cupcakes you will know the whole experience is fun. Set up a sign so that people know why you're putting up a sale.

2) Another idea is to give some of your old toys to a charity shop. This way, you could bring lots of joy to different boys and girls. You could also donate clothes and other things you don't use or need anymore.

- 3) If you have a school council or class representative, you might want to ask them if they could ask your headteacher/principal if you could hold a funfair on school grounds to raise money for charity.
- 4) This is a straight forward way to help someone. Say you were on a walk and you see someone on the street with a basket, bowl, cup or their hands out. They are hoping to receive some money. 


If you're looking to watch a good movie this half term, we have two recommendations we hope you'll enjoy as much as we did.


Raya and her family are charged with protecting a special treasure. But then something happens that puts this task at a major risk.
