

REFLECTION

The young woman Isaiah spoke about is Mary the mother of Jesus. The son she was to bear is Jesus, our Lord. Immanuel means 'God is with us.'

When God sent the Angel Gabriel to Mary, to let her know that she was to bear the Son of God, the moment Mary accepted the Angel's message, this promise from Isaiah was fulfilled. REFLECTION


Today, the Saviour of the world was born for us! Oh, what a glorious day!

"Fear not," said he for mighty dread Had seized their troubled mind "Glad tidings of great joy I bring To you and all mankind.


"To you, in David's town, this day

REFLECTION



REFLECTION

Since we humans are created in God's image (as the bible tells us in Genesis I:26), the only person we should worship is GOD alone. So, let us ask God for the grace to be like the wise men who came all the way from a far country to worship Jesus Christ.



Royal David's City


